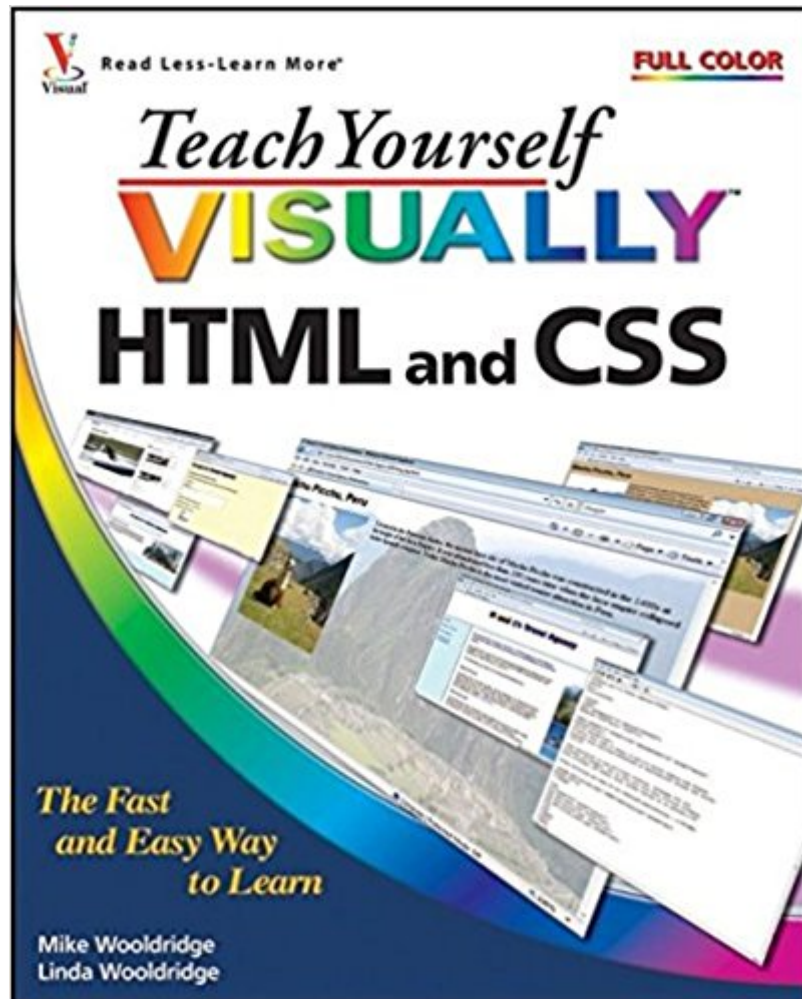

I found this book to be a great source of information on formatting my web pages with CSS, which is the main reason I bought the book. Not having much experience doing web design, this book's abundance of pictures made it easy for me to get my web page up and running in no time. If a picture is worth a thousand words, then this book is priceless!

I know I need to learn HTML and I have been totally intimidated by it. Totally! And they show you immediately how it works and it is so, so, so simple. It may be time consuming to write HTML code, but it is not that hard to learn. If you are intimidated, as I was, BUY this book! I think it will get you over that in minutes. I highly recommend it! They have another one just on HTML, I haven't seen that one, but at some point you are going to need to learn CSS. I did not think the CSS section was clear. I guess my biggest gripe about the book is that I wanted them to build a good-looking website with each step. There are a lot of graphics that are really pointless---like the ones in the header section---that space could have been used a whole lot better. They do build a rinky-dink site, but they could have done much better with that part. I think the glaring benefit of the book is that you can pick up the basics of HTML coding fast and understand what is going on even faster. For that reason alone, it was worth a WHOLE LOT MORE than the cost of a meal, which is what I paid. I also bought the Sam's 24 hr book on HTML & CSS after I bought this one. This one got me over the

intimidation of HTML, but the Sam's one is a lot clearer when it comes to CSS, and you really are going to have to learn that. If you have bad eyesight (can't see small print) the other reviewer is right, don't buy this book. The print in the examples of web pages which are on every page is REALLY small. I can see it, but someone else might not be able to.

Easy to follow, colorful design, each section clearly shows and explains the intent. As a "visual learner", I found the instructions very helpful, the large text is easy on the eyes, but the screen shots too small to see in reference to the topic. Requires use of a magnifying glass. Would like to see a major revise in layout for the next version to better incorporate the HTML windows which aid in understanding this subject matter.
