

I am very new to gardening and found this book very helpful. It is cut and dry! The plants are listed in alphabetical order explaining where to plant them and how to care for them. It also describes when and if to trim them back and if dead heading is needed. I also enjoyed how one section of the

book organized plants based on color.

I have many helpful gardening books but this one is the one I always come back to. It's best for identifying plants or finding the perfect plant for certain conditions. Great photos and lots of them!
